1. Research for Accent Clues

- a. The breakdown
- b. The sides
- c. Who is the Casting Director?
- d. IMDb
 - i. Who are Director and Producer
 - ii. Past projects? Aesthetic? Etc.?
- e. Does your agent or manager have extra and important info?

2. Reach Out to Dialect Coach

- a. Send sides and breakdown
- b. Discuss accent targeting as relates to the story

3. Schedule Sessions

- a. Schedule more than you initially think you may need
- b. Even if it's last minute!

4. Send your coach a baseline recording

5. Research People and Accent Samples

- a. Youtube, Pinterest, IDEA, actual people.
- b. KEEP IT AUTHENTIC
- c. No movies or TV shows unless they are native speakers

6. Meet with Coach

- a. Online is most likely!

7. Practice, Practice, Practice

- a. Stay in the accent as much as possible

8. Audition. Then Repeat

- a. Should I... Stay in the accent the whole time or not? Stay in the accent? Chat with casting in the accent? That depends, so ask your coach.

9. Repeat for Callbacks
